

CHAPTER 16**OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH STANDARDS**

1. General. Past practice within the Navy has been to adopt recognized general and occupational safety standards or if nonexistent, then Navy safety standards were developed and applied. These Navy-developed safety standards are equal to or better than those used by the private sector; i.e., Occupational Safety and Health Standards (OSHS), Part 1910 of Title 29 of the Code of Federal Regulation. The Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Division Lakehurst shall continue to utilize applicable safety standards consistent with the OSHS standards as they are related to recognized industrial-type operations, facilities, and equipment comparable to the "workplace" in the private sector. In situations involving unique military requirements, Navy-developed safety standards will continue to apply.

2. Areas of safety governed by special programs such as explosives and aviation are not included herein.
