

## **PRESIDENTIAL CLASSROOM VOLUNTEER INSTRUCTORS FOR THE YEAR 2000**

The Presidential Classroom is a nonpartisan, educational organization which provides this Nation's most promising high school student leaders an opportunity to participate in a dynamic study of American Government, current issues, and the inner workings of the Federal Government. Since its inception in 1968, the program has relied on a corps of volunteer instructors from the Federal Government who, with agency support, have contributed a full week of their professional and personal time to this effort. These representatives from the civil service not only offer important insights into the workings of their agencies; they also help advance the goal of rebuilding student interest in public service as a career.

The, year 2000 program's week-long sessions begin on January 22, 2000, and will continue through July 15, 2000, with 14 different weeks from which to choose. The deadline for submitting volunteer instructor applications is October 15, 1999.
