On 17 May 2004 at 2030 Hrs., the Navy Lakehurst Fire Department was dispatched via Ocean County Radio for an overturned tanker on Rt. 72, Stafford Township, by request of Station 47 Command (Chief). Assistant Chief Catapano, Captain Delbarto and the crews of Crash Truck (C-9) and Engine – 21 responded. Upon arrival, a position was set up for C-9 with Engine – 21, on the overturned tanker. The tanker containing approximately 5,000 to 8,000 gallons of heating fuel was on its side and leaking onto the roadway. The apparatus and crews of Navy Lakehurst Fire Department stood by while the Haz-Mat team tried to secure the leaks with no success due to the damage and stress of the tanker. Navy Lakehurst Fire Department remained on location until the tanker was up-righted. The apparatus and crews returned to Navy Lakehurst at 0315 Hrs.
