

**CHAPTER 7****HAZARDOUS MATERIAL CONTROL PROGRAM**

1. Purpose. To provide requirements and procedures for the control of chemicals and compounds used in work processes at the Naval Air Engineering Station Lakehurst.

- Designates command responsibilities at the facility and activity levels;
- Explains the Hazard Communication (HAZCOM) Standard, Authorized Use List (AUL) and Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS);
- Instructs the Hazardous Material (HM) user in the proper ordering, labeling, handling, storage, and transportation procedures;
- Instructs the Hazardous Waste (HW) generator in the proper collection, labeling, handling, storage, transportation and disposal procedures;
- Outlines training requirements;
- Describes the Pollution Prevention (P2) efforts to minimize the impact of HM/HW to the workers, base, and the environment.

2. Background. This HMC&M Plan, NAVAIENGSTAINST 4010.3, developed by the Supply Department, ensures that the handling of Hazardous Materials (HM) and Hazardous Waste (HW) at NAES Lakehurst is in compliance with federal, state, and local regulations as well as Navy Policy. This plan is directive in nature and is intended for use by all individuals assigned to NAES Lakehurst in permanent or temporary status (including active duty and reserve military personnel, government and contractor civilian personnel). This plan is to be used at the activity level to control and manage all HM and the resultant HW. The procedures in this plan are mandated by law or Navy policy and compliance with them is not discretionary.
