On 6 February 2004 the Navy Lakehurst Fire & Emergency Services was dispatched for mutual aid to a motor vehicle accident on Route 70 in Lakehurst Boro. Upon arrival of Assistant Chiefs Timothy Lang and Daniel Lyon, they reported the vehicles to be a tractor-trailer and a flatbed tow truck. Assistant Chief Lyon, who assumed operations, reported back to the Incident Commander that driver of the tow truck was pinned under the dashboard and appeared to have trauma to the head.

Along with the response of the Assistant Chief's, Engine Company 6321, Rescue Company 6303 and Med-1 responded to the call. Upon arrival of the emergency units, extrication equipment was deployed and further medical assessment of the patient was conducted and it was determined that the trauma sustained from the accident required rapid transportation to a regional trauma center. Incident Commander, Assistant Chief Timothy Lang, under the request of EMS personnel, requested that the New Jersey State Police Med-E-Vac be dispatched to the incident to transport the patient, but due to weather conditions the Med-E-Vac was not flying.

The Navy Lakehurst Fire & Emergency Services was assisted by MONOC paramedics in the treatment of the patient, and transported the patient to Jersey Shore Regional Trauma Center with Med-1.
