

NAES STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE

Public Safety Department (OSH Division)

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1.0 PURPOSE

Establish the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) used at Naval Air Engineering Station, Lakehurst NJ (NAESLKE), for the protection of Naval, Civilian, and Contract Personnel, from falls while working at elevated heights.

2.0 APPLICATION

This SOP is applicable to all NAES LKE facilities, operations, activities, and tenants.

4.0 PROCEDURES

1. All NAES LKE supervisors/employees, both military and civilian, who plan or assign work that may involve exposing personnel to working at elevated heights, shall formulate and submit a Fall Protection Plan prior to assigning a work party. The Fall Protection Plan shall be I.A.W. references (a) through d. as applicable, specifically for the task at hand. The Fall Protection Plan shall be submitted to the Public Safety Office, Code 8.4.1 for review and approval.
2. All Contractors under the supervision of the Resident Officer Incharge of Construction Contracts (ROICC) shall formulate and submit for review and approval, a Fall Protection Plan as a part of the required Project Safety Plan, as outlined in reference (c).
3. All Contractors under the directions of non-ROICC contracts shall formulate and submit for review and approval, a Fall Protection Plan to the Contract Specialist that complies with the applicable requirements of references (a) through (d).
4. Enclosure (1) is a sample NAES Fall Protection Plan.
